

Eyeliner Aftercare Instruction

- Pat with wet cotton pad and dry the treated area twice a day for 1 week or until healed.
- No eye makeup, eyelash extensions, strip lashes or wetting the area. You can resume your makeup routine after this period. (at least a week)
- Do not dye, perm, or use eyelash curler for 2 weeks.
- Any tools touching the treated area must be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected first.
- Sleep elevated for a new night to combat swelling
- You can ice the treated area at home. Place the ice cubes in a clean bag or paper towel and ice for a few minutes, not more than 10.
- Do not wear contact lenses during the procedure or for 24 hours after.
- Have sunglasses available. Eyes may be light sensitive or even dilated immediately after.
- The sunglasses are also handy for hiding puffy eyes. Permanent makeup will appear extremely intense and thick immediately after the procedure. The color will not even look right the first few days
